

## Waste Separation and Resource

Smaller than 60cm in length. You can dispose of your garbage from your home according to separation rules, using bags specified by the city. Please put the garbage at a designated location in your neighborhood by 8 am on the collection day.

You should not dispose of waste from stores, restaurants, offices, factories, and any other business entities at household garbage collection sites.



- Days for garbage collection differ according to living areas "ku" and/or "chonaikai". Be sure to bring your garbage to the right place on the specified collection days by referring to the charts below. Furthermore, please note that the collection days may change during New Year Holidays.
- Garbage that does not observe the separation rule will not be collected, and will be left behind with a warning seal. Since this will cause problems among neighbors, please use specified bags and put out your garbage on the collection days and times. Otherwise, an offender may be punished by the law.

Items with the mark. Large items should be flattened and bound. Small items can be put in a paper bag before binding.

**Notes** 

Newspapers, magazines, cardboard, milk cartons,

Try not to expose them to rain when disposing.

Items should be separated into categories and tied up.

Clothes/Fabric

Dispose by using clear plastic bags.

Separate into groups of steel, aluminum, and spray cans/cassette gas cans.

- Spray cans and cassette gas cans must never be disposed of inside of bags as waste!
- PET bottles should not be disposed of as Plastic Waste.

Products with built-in rechargeable batteries, such as mobile batteries, smartphones, and tablets, should not be disposed of using designated bags. It may cause fire.

#### If rechargeable batteries are removable

The products without batteries are collected at three locations in the city as small home appliances. (See the list on the back.) Otherwise, those can be disposed of as Non-burnable Waste. The rechargeable batteries with recycling marks are also collected after being isolated with cellophane tape at the three recycling centers. (See the list on the back.)





If rechargeable batteries are not removable

The products are collected at three locations in the city as small home appliances. (See the list on the back.)


#### How to dispose of dry and rechargeable batteries



Bring dry batteries to the resource collection of your neighbourhood association or three specified locations for recycling in the city. Rechargeable batteries and products with built-in rechargeable batteries are collected at three specified locations for recycling in the city. The city will not collect button batteries. Please bring button batteries into a recycling bin at electronics retail stores or such others.



#### How to Dispose of Large-sized Waste

Please apply for collection by phone to Toyoake City Cleaning Office 1-2 weeks before the collection day. (Every Wednesday) For large-sized waste, a maximum of 5 items (for five large-sized waste collection tickets) are collected per application.

- Purchase a large-sized waste disposal ticket for each large-sized waste for 1,030 yen at any of the dealers as stated below.
- After writing your name on a large-sized waste collection ticket, stick it on to a visible place of the item.
- Put the item out on to your doorstep by 08:30 on the day of collection. If you live in an apartment, please leave the item out by the entrance on the first floor.

Large-sized waste can be directly taken to the Tobu-Chita Clean Center. (Refer to "To directly bring in waste" on the right, for details)



#### Toyoake City Recycling Collection



## Items not collected at the waste disposal site

- Large-sized waste (Items over 60 cm)
- Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law (Air conditioners/TVs/refrigerators/washing machines/clothes dryers)
- Extra large-volume waste (unexpected)

Please separate the load into several collection dates, directly take to Tobu-Chita Clean Center, or request collection by businesses authorized by the city, if there is a large volume of waste from moving or

• Items difficult to process Please contact specialized businesses or discuss with the retailer the item was purchased from if you are disposing of the following items

E.g.: Scooters, motorcycles, fire extinguishers, gas cylinders, fireproof safes, accordion curtains, tires, batteries, car parts, paint, kerosene, petrol, chemicals, farm machinery and equipment, pianos, bowling balls, pachinko slot machines, calorifiers, water heaters, bathtubs, wood with the thickness of 20 cm or more and the length of 2 m or more, concrete blocks, motors, compressors, wire ropes, roof tiles, bricks, gravels, soil, CFC-using equipment, etc.

#### Waste from business activities

Garbage from stores, restaurants, offices, and factories will not be collected by the city. Please take the general waste produced by businesses directly to Tobu-Chita Clean Center or request collection to businesses authorized by the city. Furthermore, please request collection of industrial waste to businesses authorized by the prefectur

## Home Appliance Recycling Law

According to the Home Appliance Recycling Law, four home appliances (air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators, and washing machines) should be recycled by manufacturers. The items cannot be disposed of as large-sized wastes and/or small home electronics. Those cannot be brought to Tobu-Chita Clean Center, either.

TVs (liquid crystal, plasma, cathode-ray tube), refrigerators, freezers, cooler/warmer boxes, washing machines, clothes dryers, window air conditioners, etc.
