# Waste Separation and Resource Recycling

○Smaller than 60cm in length. You can dispose of your garbage from your home according to separation rules, using bags specified by the city. Please put the garbage at a designated location in your neighborhood by 8 am on the collection day.  
○You should not dispose of waste from stores, restaurants, offices, factories, and any other business entities at household garbage collection sites.

## Notes

- Garbage collection days vary depending on the ward (ku) or neighborhood association (chonaikai). Refer to the list of collection days on the reverse side, and put out your garbage at the place designated by your neighborhood association. Please note that collection days may change during the New Year Holidays.
- Garbage that does not observe the separation rule will not be collected, and will be left behind with a warning seal. Since this will cause problems among neighbors, please use specified bags and put out your garbage on the collection days and times. **Otherwise, an offender may be punished by the law.**

## Notes

**Be sure to cover your waste with a net.**

**Dispose of PET bottles as recyclables.**

If the item is left out as anything other than a recyclable, it will not be collected.

**Mobile batteries, smartphones, tablets, and other products with built-in rechargeable batteries cannot be disposed of with burnable, plastic, or non-burnable waste. It may cause a fire!**

**If the rechargeable battery is removable**  
 The main body of the product should be taken to a resource recovery center as a small home appliance. If you cannot bring it in, dispose of it as Non-burnable Waste. Rechargeable batteries with a recycling symbol should be insulated with tape and brought to a resource recovery center.

**If the rechargeable batteries cannot be removed**  
 Take the item to a resource recovery center as a small home appliance.

**How to dispose of dry and rechargeable batteries**

Dispose of dry cell batteries via your neighborhood association's waste collection site or a resource recovery center. Rechargeable batteries and products with built-in rechargeable batteries should be taken to a resource recovery center. The city will not collect button batteries. Please bring button batteries into a recycling bin at electronics retail stores or such others.

# Large-sized Waste

\*Air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators, washing machines, and clothes dryers are subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law. Do not dispose of them as large-sized waste. (Refer to the Home Appliance Recycling Law stated on the right for disposal methods)


## How to Dispose of Large-sized Waste

- 1 Please apply for collection by phone to Toyoake City Cleaning Office 1-2 weeks before the collection day. (Every Wednesday) For large-sized waste, a maximum of 5 items (for five large-sized waste collection tickets) are collected per application.

- 2 Please purchase a large-sized waste disposal ticket for large-sized items for 1,030 yen per ticket at the following stores.
- 3 After writing your name on a large-sized waste collection ticket, stick it on to a visible place of the item.
- 4 Put the item out on to your doorstep by 08:30 on the day of collection. If you live in an apartment, please leave the item out by the entrance on the first floor.



Large-sized waste can be directly taken to the Tobu-Chita Clean Center. (Refer to "To directly bring in waste" on the right, for details)

**Excluding fan heaters, stoves, microwave ovens smaller than 60 cm**

These three items can be brought to a resource recovery center as small home appliances free of charge.

- Size of large-sized waste  
Any one of the length, width, and height of the waste is **60 cm or more.**
- Large-sized waste regardless of the size  
Oil heaters, drying racks, fan heaters, stoves, microwave ovens, etc.

## Items not collected at the waste disposal site

- **Large-sized waste** (Items over 60 cm)
- **Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law** (Air conditioners/TVs/refrigerators/washing machines/clothes dryers)
- **Extra large-volume waste** (unexpected)  
Please separate the load into several collection dates, directly take to Tobu-Chita Clean Center, or request collection by businesses authorized by the city, if there is a large volume of waste from moving or spring cleaning.
- **Items difficult to process** Please contact specialized businesses or discuss with the retailer the item was purchased from if you are disposing of the following items.  
Examples: scooters, motorcycles, fire extinguishers, gas cylinders, fireproof safes, accordion curtains, tires, batteries, automotive parts, paint, kerosene, gasoline, chemicals, agricultural equipment, pianos, pachinko/slot machines, water heaters, bathtubs, wood items over 20 cm thick and 2 m long, concrete blocks, motors, compressors, wire rope, tiles, bricks, gravel, soil, equipment with CFCs, etc.
- **Waste from business activities**  
Garbage from stores, restaurants, offices, and factories will not be collected by the city. Please take the general waste produced by businesses directly to Tobu-Chita Clean Center or request collection to businesses authorized by the city. Furthermore, please request collection of industrial waste to businesses authorized by the prefecture.

## Home Appliance Recycling Law

According to the Home Appliance Recycling Law, four home appliances (air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators, and washing machines) should be recycled by manufacturers. The items cannot be disposed of as large-sized wastes and/or small home electronics. Those cannot be brought to Tobu-Chita Clean Center, either.

### Subject items

Televisions (OLED, LCD, plasma, CRT), refrigerators, freezers, coolers, hot/cold containers, washing machines, clothes dryers, air conditioners, wind-type air conditioners, etc.



1) Can you tell the store that you will buy a new one or bought the old one? **Yes** → Please ask them to pick up the old one.

2) Where can you bring in by yourself?

→ In a specified pick-up site

Purchase a home appliance recycling ticket at a post office in advance. In addition to the recycling fee, a transfer fee will be charged.

→ In a nearby store

Ask them for collection. In addition to the recycling fee, a transportation cost will be charged.

→ Unable to bring in

Ask a nearby store or accredited collection contractor for collection. In addition to the recycling fee, a transportation cost will be charged.

Bring the home appliance to be disposed of along with the Home Appliance Recycling Ticket you have paid for to a designated collection site.

## To directly bring in waste

**Open** 8:30 am to 12:00 am, 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm, Weekdays and Saturdays (including national holidays, except New Year Holidays)

- For bringing in waste, separate burnable from non-burnable waste beforehand. You should take them into the center by yourself with your driver's license or any other ID for address confirmation.

- Both of household waste and business waste (excluding industrial waste) are collected for 200 yen per 10 kg.
