○ Garbage items smaller than 60 cm: Please place them in city-designated garbage bags according to the sorting rules and put them out at the designated neighborhood collection point between sunrise and 8:00 AM on the collection day.
○ You should not dispose of waste from stores, restaurants, offices, factories, and any other business entities at household garbage collection sites. These items will not be collected.

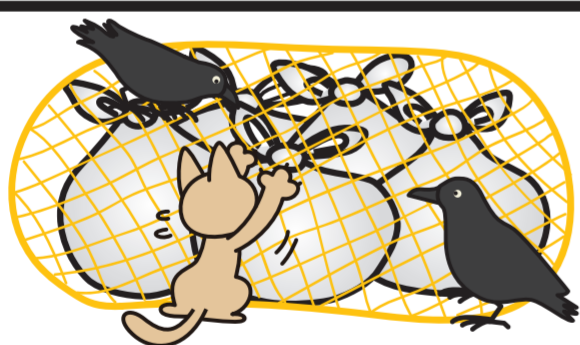

Notes

- Garbage collection days vary depending on the ward (ku) or neighborhood association (chonaikai). Refer to the list of collection days on the reverse side, and put out your garbage at the place designated by your neighborhood association. Please note that collection days may change during the New Year Holidays.
- Garbage that does not observe the separation rule will not be collected, and will be left behind with a warning seal. Since this will cause problems among neighbors, please use specified bags and put out your garbage on the collection days and times. **Otherwise, an offender may be punished by the law.**

Important Notes



To help keep garbage collection areas clean, please follow these guidelines.

- Cover garbage securely with a crow-prevention net.**
▶ This helps prevent crows and other animals from pulling it off.
- Try to keep food waste out of sight.**
▶ Place food waste in the center of the garbage bag, or wrap it in a paper bag or newspaper. This helps prevent crows and other animals from scattering the garbage.
- Put out garbage on the designated day and at the designated location.**
▶ Please put out garbage between sunrise and 8:00 AM on the collection day.
- Check the garbage sorting rules before disposal.**
▶ Garbage that is not properly sorted will not be collected. Please refer to this leaflet when disposing of garbage.

*Air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators, washing machines, and clothes dryers are subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law. Do not dispose of them as large-sized waste. (Refer to the Home Appliance Recycling Law stated on the right for disposal methods)

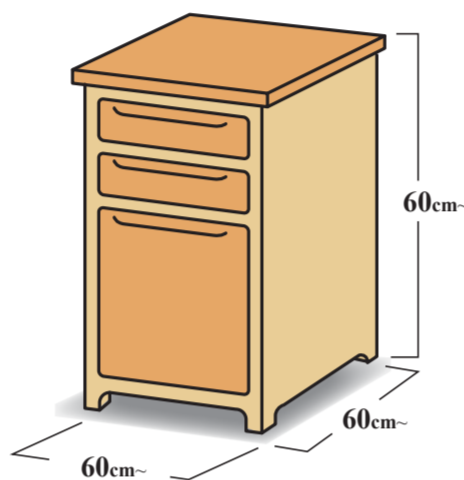
How to Dispose of Large-sized Waste

- 1 Please call the reservation hotline to apply for collection 1–2 weeks before the collection day (every Wednesday). For large-sized waste, a maximum of five items (five large-sized waste collection tickets) can be collected per application.

- 2 Please purchase a large-sized waste disposal ticket for large-sized items for 1,030 yen per ticket at the following stores.
- 3 After writing your name on a large-sized waste collection ticket, stick it on to a visible place of the item.
- 4 Put the item out on to your doorstep by 08:30 on the day of collection. If you live in an apartment, please leave the item out by the entrance on the first floor.

- Size of large-sized waste
Any one of the length, width, and height of the waste is **60 cm or more.**
- Large-sized waste regardless of the size
Oil heaters, drying racks, fan heaters, stoves, microwave ovens, etc.

Excluding fan heaters, stoves, microwave ovens smaller than 60 cm
These three items can be brought to a resource recovery center as small home appliances free of charge.

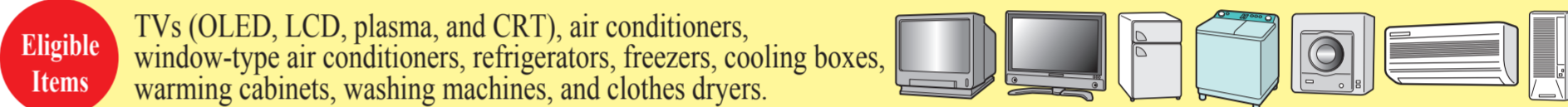
Items not collected at the waste disposal site

- **Large-sized waste** (Items over 60 cm)
- **Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law** (Air conditioners/TVs/refrigerators/washing machines/clothes dryers)
- **Extra large-volume waste** (unexpected)
Please separate the load into several collection dates, directly take to Tobu-Chita Clean Center, or request collection by businesses authorized by the city, if there is a large volume of waste from moving or spring cleaning.
- **Items difficult to process** Please contact specialized businesses or discuss with the retailer the item was purchased from if you are disposing of the following items.
Examples: scooters, motorcycles, fire extinguishers, gas cylinders, fireproof safes, accordion curtains, tires, batteries, automotive parts, paint, kerosene, gasoline, chemicals, agricultural equipment, pianos, pachinko/slot machines, water heaters, bathtubs, wood items over 20 cm thick and 2 m long, concrete blocks, motors, compressors, wire rope, tiles, bricks, gravel, soil, equipment with CFCs, etc.
- **Waste from business activities**
Garbage from stores, restaurants, offices, and factories will not be collected by the city. Please take the general waste produced by businesses directly to Tobu-Chita Clean Center or request collection to businesses authorized by the city. Furthermore, please request collection of industrial waste to businesses authorized by the prefecture.

TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators, and washing machines

Under the Home Appliance Recycling Law, four designated appliances—TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators, and washing machines—are recycled by their manufacturers. They cannot be disposed of as large-sized waste or small electronic appliances. They also cannot be brought directly to the Tobu Chita Clean Center (EcoRe).



① Are you replacing the appliance? Or do you know the store where you purchased it? Yes → Please ask the store where you purchased (or will purchase) the appliance to take it back.

Please purchase a “Home Appliance Recycling Ticket” at a post office in advance (a handling fee will be charged). Bring the appliance you wish to dispose of and the paid recycling ticket to the designated collection point.

- The fee is 200yen per 10kg. (As of January 2026)
- When bringing in pruned branches, certain procedures or conditions may apply. Please contact the City Hall Environmental Affairs Division in advance for details.
- When bringing garbage, please separate it in advance into burnable and non-burnable waste.
- The person who generated the waste must bring it and present identification (such as a driver's license) showing they are a resident of Toyoake City.
- If someone other than the person who generated the waste brings it in, please contact the Environmental Affairs Division at City Hall in advance.
- Depending on the type or amount of garbage, it may not be accepted. If you have any questions, please contact the City Hall Environmental Affairs Division or the Tobu Chita Clean Center (EcoRe).
