Basic Principle

Toyoake City Government and residents working together toward the goal of gender equality

We are working toward the goal of a society of equality between genders, in which men and women both respect each others' human rights and share responsibilities, and where each person can use his or her individual gifts and abilities to their full potential as equal members of society.

Based on the principle of the Basic Law on Gender Equality, the Toyoake City Government will strive to ensure opportunities for participation in all areas of society and to correct discrepancies between men and women, and will work with residents to promote this plan.

Social Goals of This Plan

A society in which every person is respected regardless of gender, age, or nationality, and is equally able to receive social and cultural benefits.



A society in which people can choose a variety of ways of living of their own volition and responsibility.

A society in which both men and women can use their individuality and abilities to their full potential in every area, including homes, local communities, workplaces, and policy decision-making.

A society in which men and women support each other, and can live in security and confident throughout their lives.

Period of Plan

This plan covers the eight-year period from 2007 to 2014.

It may be revised if necessary to respond appropriately to changes in social circumstances.

What sort of policies is Toyoake City considering for its foreign residents?

From a gender equality perspective

Ensuring people can live in security and safety throughout their lives

The number of foreign residents has rapidly increased in recent years, and there is a need to work to resolve issues faced by foreigners in the region.

Issue: Support for foreign women

Foreigners are in a vulnerable position in places where their language or customs are different. Toyoake City is enhancing its consultation system to enable it to collaborate in solving problems faced by foreign women in particular, such as education and domestic violence.

In addition, the Fourth Comprehensive Plan for Toyoake City includes a number of policies and projects planned for the purpose of promoting support for foreign residents and international exchange. Some of these are described below.

- Holding lectures on Japanese living habits and Japanese language classes, to enable foreign residents to understand Japanese lifestyles.
- Printing and distribution of informational publications in several languages. (Digests in Portuguese, English, and Chinese are already distributed to public facilities within the city.)
- Improving and expanding international events held by the city with the aim of enabling social interaction between foreign and Japanese residents, in collaboration with the Toyoake International Relations Association (TIRA).
