Routine vaccinations for children (子どもの定期予防接種)

Routine vaccines include the 5-in-1 vaccine, BCG vaccine, MR vaccine, 2-in-1 vaccine, and those for rotavirus, Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib), pneumococcal infection in children, hepatitis B, chickenpox, Japanese encephalitis, and human papillomavirus (HPV).

Have your child vaccinated at a medical institution at the appropriate time for each vaccination.

Effective on October 1, 2025

Ordinance on promoting the proper use of smartphones and other devices.

(スマートフォン等の適正使用の推進に関する条例)



Toyoake City has enacted an ordinance in the hope that all citizens will live healthy lives. Why not take this opportunity to reflect on whether you are getting sufficient sleep and whether your daily routine suits you?

Underlying recognition

The City acknowledges that smartphones and similar devices are convenient and essential in daily life.

Purpose

Since sufficient sleep is essential, the city aims to prevent the excessive use of smartphones and other devices from negatively affecting citizens' physical health, mental well-being, and daily lives.

Target citizens

All citizens and children under 18 attending schools in the city



Goal

- •A daily limit of up to approximately two hours is recommended for the use of smartphones and other similar devices during leisure time.
- •It is recommended that elementary school students and younger refrain from using such devices after 9:00 p.m. and junior high school students and older after 10:00 p.m.
- •It is advisable that families establish their own rules regarding appropriate usage times and timeframes for each family member.

The primary purpose of the ordinance is to ensure sufficient sleeping hours.

The Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare recommends 9–12 hours of sleep for elementary school children, 8–10 hours for junior and senior high school children, and 6–8 hours for adults. Since sufficient sleep is especially essential for children's physical and mental development, recommended usage times and periods are determined by calculating backward from the necessary amount of sleep.

This limit of up to two hours per day applies to leisure time.

Leisure time is the time that you can use freely, excluding the time for working, studying, commuting, and other activities. Furthermore, the two-hour limit is intended only as a guideline, and extending this to three or four hours is acceptable as long as it does not interfere with sleep or family communication. The ordinance is intended not to restrict citizens' rights. The purpose of the ordinance is to raise awareness about the appropriate use of smartphones.

Content

Rules that everyone can agree on

Families are encouraged to set household rules for using smartphones and other devices. It is recommended for parents not to unilaterally impose rules on their children, but to discuss and create rules that both can agree on and that lead to improved smartphone use.

The purpose of the ordinance is to raise awareness about the appropriate use of smartphones.

The City will not intervene in or direct the daily lives of citizens. Furthermore, it is not necessary for parents and children, spouses, or friends to compare their respective smartphone usage times.

- Payment using credit card points is not accepted.
